Steve provided the location in the Greenport Yacht & Shipbuilding shipyard for the re-construction, launching down the marine railway, and loading on sea-going barges for the replicated Long Beach Bar "Bug" Lighthouse. Without Steve's generous and critical support, the rebuilding of this historic lighthouse – which now serves as an important Federal Aid to Navigation -- would not have been possible. He has repeatedly and consistently provided maritime support including barge transportation of materials and equipment for repairs at the Long Beach Bar "Bug" Lighthouse.

Steve is the present owner and manager of Greenport Yacht & Shipbuilding Company from 1970 to the present day. He plans and directs work on private, commercial and government vessels of up to 300 tons including historic restoration. Steve maintains and operates one of the few remaining marine railways in the country.

Steve worked with the Smith Meal Menhaden fishing companies from Nova Scotia to Sabine Pass, Texas.

Steve graduated from Hobart College with a Bachelor of Science Degree. He served as a Company Commander in the U.S. Marine Corps, 2nd Marine Division.
